

## COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIPS DUTIES

- Organize the Meet – League Chairs (Sean Curynski/Mike LaFrance-JV, Varsity, Varsity”B”); Charlie Lowe-Modified)
- Create team/scoring packets – Sean Curynski-Eastridge, Dave Yen
- Work Chute, Hand Out Ribbons to each finisher **AND assist with chip removal and collection** – minimum 2 people per team for each race
  - Modified Girls – Thomas, Greece Arcadia
  - Modified Boys – Mendon, Victor
  - JV Girls – Brighton, Athena, Spencerport
  - JV Boys – Canandaigua, Churchville, Hilton
  - Varsity Girls – Olympia/Odyssey, Sutherland
  - Varsity Boys – HFL, Penfield, Irondequoit
  - Varsity “B” Girls – Batavia, Fairport, Thomas
  - Varsity “B” Boys – Gates Chili, Schroeder, Rush Henrietta
- Set up Crew – Eastridge, Brockport, Hilton, Rush Henrietta, Athena – all others are welcome
- Take down schools –Greece Arcadia, Brighton, Eastridge, Brockport, Rush Henrietta, Mendon, all others
- Score the Meet – Yen Timing
- Officials – Rick Smith
- Provide mic/speakers – Greece Arcadia, Rush Henrietta
- Awards – Eastridge, Brockport, Churchville, Mendon
- Jury of Appeals – Sutherland, Schroeder, Churchville, Canandaigua, League Chairs

*Remember, for an athlete to be considered for All County, he/she need to have competed in a minimum of three league meets. If he/she does not have this minimum, a letter of hardship must be submitted to the league chair giving medical reasons and documentation why this minimum was not met. A letter of hardship is not needed for athletes competing in non-varsity races.*

**If you have an athlete, whether that individual is yours or on another team, that you feel may qualify for the state meet, and as such, should be considered for the sportsmanship award, please submit those names to the league chairman at the county meet. Following the sectionals, we will be asked who we recommend for this award, we need names.**

## SECTIONALS

All entries will be electronic through Yen Timing. **Entry deadline is SUNDAY, OCTOBER 31 8:00 PM**

All entries must have met NYS and Section V guidelines (must have competed in six meets). Requests for a waiver must be made by the coach and athletic director and have supporting evidence.

As league chairman, we need your verification sheets, with signatures. Failure to provide such sheets will result in your team not being allowed to run. You may want to hand in sheets at counties. A copy of the verification sheet is available on the Section V website.
