1. Entry deadline is Sunday, October 19, by 8:00pm
2. Entries are made on YenTiming, not the MC XC website
3. You do not need to designate who will run in each race

Important Information:

1. There is a \$5 per car entrance fee. Please encourage your spectators to use the link below to purchase digital tickets in advance (cash will be accepted at the park):

2. Please have athletes at the starting line 10 minutes before the scheduled start of each race
3. Each athlete should wear their designated bib number on the front of their jersey
4. The varsity race should be your top team. The JV race is for 9th and 10th graders only (as voted on in 2018).
5. Coaches please plan to be at the coaches meeting on time
6. Awards will start no later than 5:40. We will be abbreviating the ceremony to ensure daylight by announcing the top-10 in each sub-varsity race but not calling them up to the stage. We will ask that they collect their awards after the ceremony and can use the area for pictures.
7. Please ensure the park is left clean and free of garbage
8. If there are any questions or concerns, please see the officials or league chairs near the finish line.
9. Matchplayink will be selling T-Shirts online and onsite
10. Please make sure to share the parking information with your transportation department and parents.
11. Please make sure to review your team duties for the day

Awards: 1. Team trophies to the winning teams in each sub-varsity race; Top 5 teams in Varsity

2. Individual awards to the top 10 individuals in each race
3. First Team All-County patches to the top 32 individuals in each varsity race*
4. All-County certificates to the top 64 individuals in each varsity race*
5. T-Shirts to the top 32 in each varsity race
6. Jason DeJoy Cup – Given to the school with the top combined times for their first 5 girls and first 5 boys. If there is a tie, the times of a school's sixth male and female runner will be taken.
7. Dave Hennessey 5th Runner Award - fastest 5th male and female runners

***League requires a minimum of 2 league meets to be eligible. Athletes who do not have three meets must submit a hardship petition to be considered.**

Championship Duties (as of 8/8/25, subject to change):

- Organize the Meet – League Chairs (Nolan Hoh and Dave Klehr)
- Create team/scoring packets – Dave Klehr, Dave Yen
- Work Chute,
 - Monroe County Official(s) will help make sure athletes get through the corral in a timely manner
- Set up Crew – HFL, Schroeder, Hilton, Rush Henrietta, Athena – **all others are welcome**
- Take down schools –Churchville-Chili, Brockport, HFL, Rush Henrietta, Schroeder,**all others are welcome**
- Score the Meet – Yen Timing
- Officials – Rick Smith
- Provide mic/speakers – Greece Arcadia, Rush Henrietta
- Awards – Batavia, Eastridge, Penfield, Webster Thomas, Mendon
- Jury of Appeals – Brighton, Gates-Chili, Fairport, League Chairs (HFL, Schroeder)

Remember, for an athlete to be considered for All County, he/she needs to have competed in a minimum of two league meets. If he/she does not have this minimum, a letter of hardship must be submitted to the league chair giving medical reasons and documentation why this minimum was not met. A letter of hardship is not needed for athletes competing in non-varsity races.

If you have an athlete, whether that individual is yours or on another team, that you feel may qualify for the state meet, and as such, should be considered for the sportsmanship award, please submit those names to the league chairman at the county meet. Following sectionals, we will be asked who we recommend for this award, we need names.

SECTIONALS

All entries will be electronic through Yen Timing. **Entry deadline is SUNDAY, November 2nd 8:00 PM.** All entries must have met NYS and Section V guidelines (must have competed in six meets). Requests for a waiver must be made by the coach and athletic director and have supporting evidence. Verification sheets are no longer required. Entries on YenTiming now supplement.
